

Artist and Art piece Biography

Concept information:

Velazquez's dream was born from the experience of transferring the masterpiece of Las Meninas to the level of pure comics. A deconstruction of the forms that connects with the idea of how each of the great Masters of Modern painting would have treated the cast of characters. From Magritte to Soto, passing through Mondrian. The result is a "collage" where the great artists shake hands with the "comic" concept that represents Velázquez himself. The author's signature is printed on the work, through his characteristic beach ball, which will mark Sandoval's work.

Artist bio:

Born in Venezuela in 1968 and currently living in Spain, the name of Pedro Sandoval is currently closely associated with the abstract neo-expressionist movement and is the creator of the PENTAABSTRACTIONISM movement worldwide. Today Pedro Sandoval's works can be found in different museums around the world, as well as in large collections such as the White House, the Vatican Museums, the Kennedy family, the Thyssen-Bornemisza family, among others.
